IMPORTANT! Marriage does not entitle a foreign national to stay legally in Lithuania, but they may apply for a residence permit when they get



APOSTILLE CERTIFICATES AND LEGALISATION PROCEDURE

- An Apostille may be obtained from a competent authority in the country of issue (for instance, in Lithuania, documents are certified with an Apostille by the notaries public) or at a diplomatic mission abroad. A list of countries eligible for document certification with an Apostille can be found on the back of this leaflet.
- Documents issued in the countries that are not on the list must be legalised (double certification). First, the issued document will have to be legalised by a competent authority (as a general rule, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs) or a diplomatic mission of the issuing country. Then the document needs to be translated into Lithuanian and legalised by the Lithuanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
