



For each born or adopted child, regardless of the fact that the benefit has already been paid out to the child after he/she is born, a **single payment** in the amount of 11 base social benefits (440 Euros) is granted. The one-off payment is paid out to one of the parents of the child (or a single parent) (adoptive parents) or a child's guardian.

To get a lump-sum child benefit, after having registered child's birth and declared the place of residence, one of the parents has to submit a request for the benefit to a social support department no later than within one year since the child was born. You need to bring Lithuanian birth certificate as well as your passport/ID. The application for the benefit can also be submitted [online through the E-Government Gateway](#) if you use electronic banking or have an electronic signature to identify yourself. To be eligible for a benefit, one of the parents and the child must be registered in Lithuania and the data about the birth of the child has to be in the registry of Lithuanian residents.
