



### **Which document can I get?**

You can get a temporary residence certificate.

### **How long will the document be valid for?**

The certificate is issued for **5 years** or for the intended period of your residence in the Republic of Lithuania if this period is less than 5 years.

### **Where can I apply for a temporary residence certificate?**

You have to submit your application and documents for the issue of the certificate **in person** through the Lithuanian Migration Information System (hereinafter [MIGRIS](#)). Within 4 months from the date of submission of the application and the documents within the MIGRIS, you must personally come to the chosen [branch of the Migration Department](#) and submit the original documents, biometric data and sign the application.

### **How much will it cost to apply for the temporary residence certificate?**

Prior to lodging the application, the state fee in the amount of **8,60 EUR** for the issuance or replacement of the certificate must be paid.

### **What documents do I need to submit?**

1. an application of the specified form (submitted electronically through the Lithuanian Migration Information System [MIGRIS](#));
2. a valid passport of an EU citizen or an identity card;
3. the documents confirming the ground for the issuance of the certificate:
  - documents certifying the basis for issuing the certificate: employment contract; or
  - a letter from the company, institution or organisation posting you to the Republic of Lithuania confirming your legal employment in the Republic of Lithuania; or
  - a document certifying that you are the owner and/or manager of a company, institution or organisation registered in the Republic of Lithuania; or
  - other documents proving your legitimate activities in Lithuania.

### **How long will it take to process my application?**

An EU citizen's application must be considered and a decision on it must be adopted **not later than within 1 month** from the date of submission of the application.
