



A foreigner holding a national visa (D) may enter the Republic of Lithuania and stay in the country for a period of time specified in the visa. This period may be up to 12 months. There are single-entry and multi-entry national visas (D). **A single-entry national visa (D)** is issued to a foreigner who has been granted temporary or permanent residence in the Republic of Lithuania. **A multi-entry national visa (D) is usually granted for foreigners who arrive to work, study, conduct scientific researches or to engage in legal activities in Lithuania.** More information about issuance of National visa (D) can be found on the [website of the Migration Department](#). National visas are issued for the duration of **no more than 1 year**.

If a foreigner had been granted a 1-year multi-entry national visa, another multi-entry national visa may only be issued **if more than 180 days have passed since expiration of the previous visa**.

If a foreigner had been granted a multi-entry national visa and applied for a new multi-entry visa **before the expiration of the previous one**, he or she may be granted a multi-entry visa with the validity period (as well as the validity period of the held multi-entry national visa) of no more than 1 year.

If a multi-entry national visa granted to a foreigner had been **revoked** and the foreigner applied for a new multi-entry national visa within 90 days after the decision to revoke the foreigner's previous multi-entry national visa had taken legal effect, he or she may be granted a multi-entry visa with the validity period (as well as the validity period of the held multi-entry national visa) of no more than 1 year;

If a foreigner had been granted a 1 year multi-entry national visa, **less than 90 days passed since its expiration** and the foreigner applied for a permit to reside in the Republic of Lithuania or a residence card of a family member of a citizen of the European Union, he or she may be granted a multi-entry national visa for the validity period of no more than 5 months after the application submission date.

Applicants for a national visa shall pay a **visa fee of EUR 120**. The visa application is completed **online**. A list of required documents can be found [here](#).

A foreigner holding a valid national visa (D) may travel the territories of other states of the Schengen Area, but no more than 90 days within any 180-day period.
